<i>Initial here</i>	<b>Mission</b> – WorldFest is a an annual campus-wide cultural festival and Earth Day event with three broad themes of: People, Cultures, and the Earth (environment) which allow students, faculty, staff, and managers from all campus departments to participate!
<i>Initial here</i>	<b>Content</b> – As an institution of higher education, we value and promote the free exchange of ideas. Freedom of expression is guaranteed in the college where such expression does not violate District policy, campus rules, including laws on illegal harassment and discrimination, or create a clear and present danger of the commission of unlawful acts, or the substantial disruption of the orderly operation of the College, or disrupt activities already scheduled for that day and time in the designated areas. (NOCCCD Board Policy AP 3900 Speech: Time, Place, and Manner) Event organizers reserve the right to review all displays/activities for potential violations of this District Board policy.
<i>Initial here</i>	<b>Designated Art Space</b> – Artist will be designated a section of the quad to complete their artwork. Artist will be restricted to their designated space and may not impede upon another artist space. Artist may begin their work no earlier than 8:00am on the day of WorldFest and <b>MUST</b> complete their artwork no later than 1:45pm that day to allow for judging.
<i>Initial here</i>	<b>Art Supplies</b> – The Cadena Cultural Center provides very limited chinks (not of professional quality) for the use of our artist. Artist may only use water-soluble chinks.
<i>Initial here</i>	<b>Damage</b> - <b>NO PERMANENT CHALK, PAINT, ETC. is allowed.</b> <b>Artists understand that they may be liable for any and all damages cause by use of permanent paint, chalk, etc.</b>
