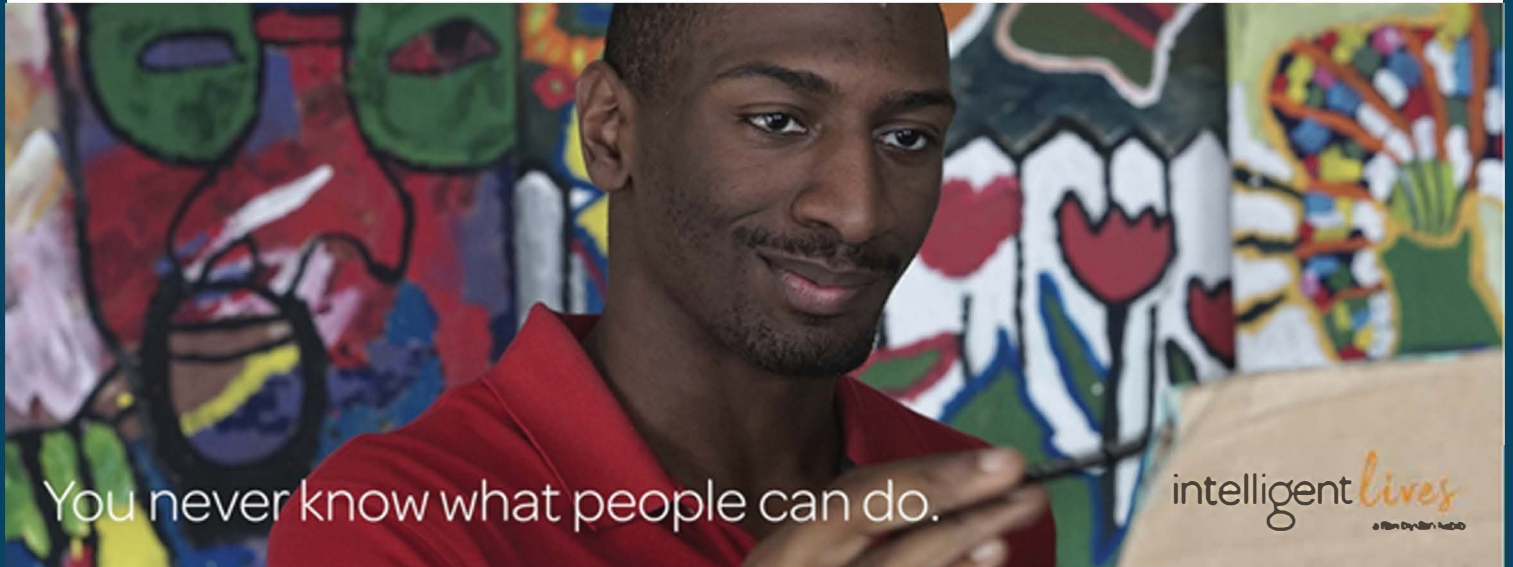

Intelligent Lives: A discussion focused on the inclusion of students with disabilities



The Intelligent Lives webinar will be a discussion oriented seminar that utilizes the documentary “Intelligent Lives” as a spring-board for a conversation about inclusion. Specifically, the discussion will focus on the inclusion of individuals with intellectual disabilities (ID), autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and other developmental disabilities into college, employment and the community.

The Bouclys will share a parent’s perspective as they anticipate what their son will need when he transitions to college and his adult life.
